The car parks were full to capacity, the children had loads of fun with all the activities and the parents were totally enthralled by the authors and illustrator's presentations and Q&A's. With sincere thanks to UWC, without whom, we would not have been able to broadcast this festival worldwide.

For the second year in a row, we awarded the only one of its kind in SA – a Laureate award for lifetime commitment to children's literature. These awards are representative of our Literary Festival's mascot – Big Ears Teddy Bear – the big ears to take in more stories.
